CAC College and University Examination Site Audits

Policy – A random sample of 10% of the college and university examination sites administering the CAC certification examination will be audited by a Certified Professional Constructor selected by the Certification Manager.

Introduction – There are two categories of certification examination sites. The first are Kryterion Testing Centers and the second are those at educational institutions and other entities approved by the Constructor Certification Commission (CCC). For the first category, the administration of both certification examinations is conducted by Kryterion Testing Centers in accordance with its manual entitled "Kryterion Testing Network Kyterion Testing Standards" which has been reviewed and approved by the CCC as meeting its Policies on testing and includes independent auditing of their sites.
